

SISTER ROSMUNDA ROHR, MPF

Sr. Rosmunda Rohr, MPF, 96, passed away peacefully on Sunday, October 31, 2021, at St. Joseph Hall, Morristown, NJ.

A viewing will be held on Thursday, November 4, beginning at 2:00 p.m., in St. Lucy Chapel, Villa Walsh, Morristown, NJ, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 4:00 p.m. The services are limited to family members and Religious Teachers Filippini. Born in Jersey City, NJ, Sr. Rosmunda entered the Religious Teachers Filippini in 1940. She received the habit in 1941 and made her religious profession in 1944.

Sr. Rosmunda earned a degree from Villa Walsh Normal School in 1947, and also earned a certificate and diploma in Religion.

In her first 20 years of religious life, Sr. Rosmunda served in the following (arch)dioceses: Baltimore, Hartford, Newark, Ogdensburg, Providence, Scranton, and Trenton.

Born with the heart of a missionary, in 1962, Sr. Rosmunda was one of the first five Filippini Sisters to open a mission in Sao Paulo, Brazil where she first served as a teacher and catechist, and eventually as Vice Provincial Superior.

Faithful to the spirit of her oblation, Sr. Rosmunda also served in leadership roles in Ireland and England.

In 2010, Sr. Rosmunda returned to the United States, taking up residence in St. Joseph Hall, Villa Walsh, Morristown, NJ.

Sr. Rosmunda is predeceased by her parents Frank Rohr and Mary Knox, her three brothers, Frank, William and Victor Rohr, and one sister, Connie. She is survived by her sister Carla, numerous nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews.
