



SISTER DOLORES JENSEN, MPF

Sister Dolores Jensen, MPF, died peacefully on Thursday, March 6, 2025, at Troy Hills Center, Parsippany, New Jersey. She was 88 years of age.

A viewing will be held on Thursday, March 13, beginning at 2:00 p.m., in St. Lucy Chapel, Villa Walsh, Morristown, New Jersey, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 4:00 p.m. The interment will take place at Ave Maria Cemetery after the Liturgy. Arrangements are by Doyle Funeral Home, Morristown.

Born in Orange, New Jersey, Sister Dolores entered the Religious Teachers Filippini in 1951. She received the habit in 1952 and made her religious profession in 1955.

Sister Dolores studied Elementary Education, earning a BS degree from the College of St. Elizabeth in Convent Station, New Jersey.

During her 72 years of religious life, Sister Dolores generously and creatively ministered as elementary school teacher in the (arch)dioceses of Baltimore, Bridgeport, Metuchen, Newark, - Philadelphia, Santa Fe, Scranton, and Trenton. She served as Principal in the arch(dioceses) of Newark and Charleston, South Carolina. Additionally, Sister Dolores assumed the role of local convent superior. Sister Dolores' last assignment was in 2000 when she and three other Sisters began their ministry at St. Thomas Aquinas Parish and School in Rio Rancho, New Mexico. Sister Dolores transitioned to Villa Walsh in 2016 due to health issues, and in 2023 resided in St. Joseph Hall Infirmary.

Sister Dolores is predeceased by her parents Robert and Angelina (DeVingo) Jensen, her brothers Robert and Ted, and her sisters Marion Biondi and Beverly Norton. Sister Dolores is survived by many nieces, nephews, grandnieces, and grandnephews.
