



SISTER LORRAINE CHAUDRON, MPF

Sister Lorraine Chaudron, MPF, died peacefully on Saturday, June 20, 2026, at St. Joseph Hall, Villa Walsh, Morristown, New Jersey. She was 92 years of age.

A viewing will be held on Thursday, June 25, beginning at 10:00 a.m. in St. Lucy Chapel, Villa Walsh, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 11:00 a.m. After the Liturgy, interment will take place at Ave Maria Cemetery. Arrangements are by Doyle Funeral Home, Morristown, New Jersey.

Born and raised in Jersey City, New Jersey, Sister Lorraine entered the Religious Teachers Filippini in 1950. She received the habit in 1951 and professed her Perpetual Oblation in 1954. Sister Lorraine earned her B.S. and M.A. degrees in Elementary Education from Seton Hall University, South Orange, New Jersey.

In her 74 years of religious life, Sister Lorraine served as classroom teacher and catechist in the (arch)dioceses of Hartford, Metuchen, Newark, Pittsburgh, and Providence. She also was asked to serve as local convent Superior. Sister Lorraine's most enduring legacy was forged at St. Peter School in Torrington, Connecticut, where she served faithfully for 26 years—longer than any other single location. During the years 1979 to 1988 and 1989 to 2006 she blessed the parish and school communities with her outstanding teaching and joyful, fun-loving spirit. Though her most recent years were marked by declining health, Sister Lorraine still emanated the joy of the Lord. In 2022, she took up residence at St. Joseph Hall at Villa Walsh in Morristown, New Jersey.

Sister Lorraine is predeceased by her parents, Edward and Camille (Marino) Chaudron. She is survived by her fellow Religious Teachers Filippini, the many people she impacted through her life of generous service, and friends.
